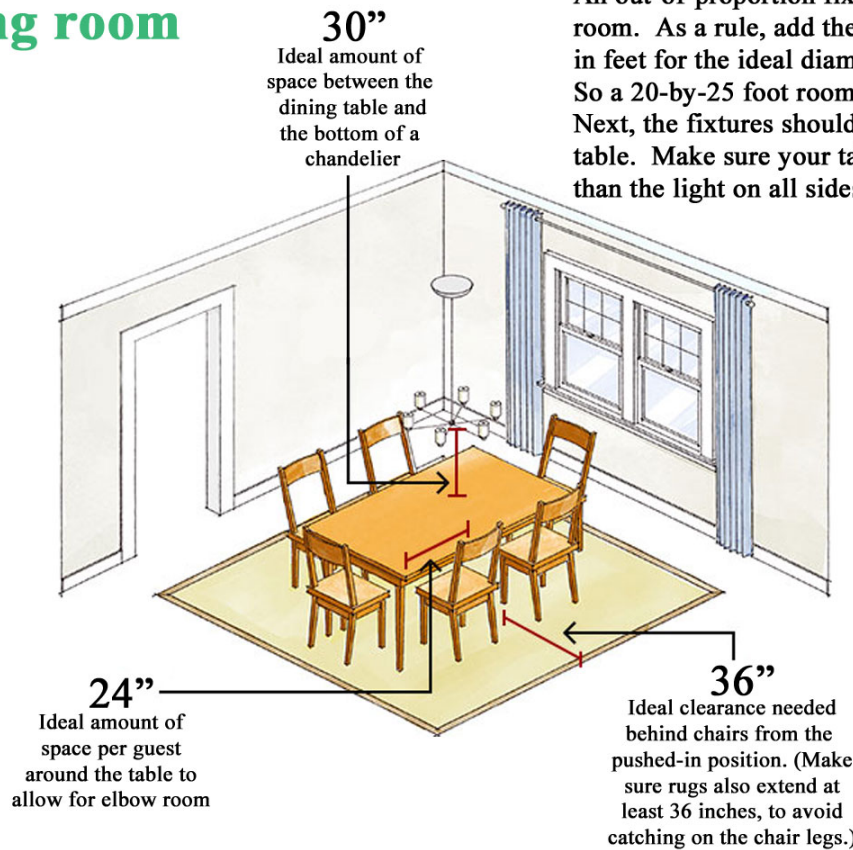

Need-to-know numbers: the dining room

Choose the right-size light fixture

An out-of-proportion fixture can throw off an entire room. As a rule, add the length and width of the room in feet for the ideal diameter of the fixture, in inches. So a 20-by-25 foot room calls for a 45-inch fixture. Next, the fixtures should be proportionate to the dining table. Make sure your table is at least 1 foot wider than the light on all sides.



How to measure for a medallion

To calculate the ideal diameter of a medallion in inches, divide the square footage of the room by 7. For a 10-by-10 foot room, divide 100 by 7. The resulting number, 14, is the appropriate medallion diameter, in inches..
