

# Design a Wood Pergola in 6 easy steps.

## 1 Choose a size

### Things to consider:

How much space do you have available?

Berlin Gardens measurements are based on the TOP dimensions, not the "footprint" of the posts. The posts are set in 16" from the outside edge of the purlins and beams.

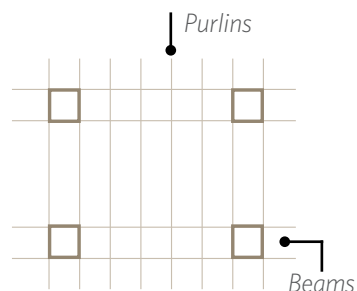
### Sizes (outside to outside of top)

Widths (purlins) available: 10', 12', 14', 16', 18'

Lengths (beams) available: 10', 12', 14', 16', 18', 20', 22', 24'

Beams and purlins extend 16" past post positions.

Pergolas 20' feet and above will have 6 posts.

Paver Stone

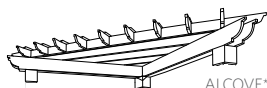


In-ground

\*Alcove is only available in 8', 10' and 12'.



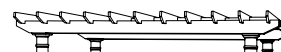
