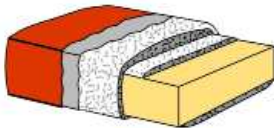
General Information

Frame & Finish:

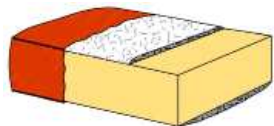
Our frames are constructed of hardwood. We offer over 50 finishes at no additional upcharge. Each style is standard with a Mahogany finish. Although we employ identical preparation and finishing processes, matching finishes cannot be guaranteed.



Standard Cushions: Our cushion provides the absolute best in feather and down seating. Cushions consist of a polyurethane core wrapped in 50% fiber and 50% duck feathers and down as well as our back cushions. Throw pillows consist of 95% feathers and 5% down. This precious seating needs TLC. We recommend that they are constantly fluffed and turned frequently. Occasionally a feather or two will appear. This means the cover is doing its job, breathing, which assures your comfort.



Plush Cushions: Featured as standard in some styles, this cushion offers a premium high resiliency polyurethane core generously wrapped in premium polyurethane fiber, all encased in a down proof ticking. This cushion offers great softness and is designed to allow wrinkling and puddling to accentuate the design and comfort. This is not an optional cushion.



City Living Cushions: Our City Living cushion is standard in all City Living styles. The seat cushions are of virgin urethane foam with a layer of spun polyester on the top and bottom for added plushness but yet very durable. This is not an optional cushion.

Dimensions:

Approximate dimensions are listed with each individual style in this catalog. Our frames and furniture are custom made; therefore dimensions may vary slightly from printed size. We measure dimensions as follows:

W (Width) is the widest part of the piece, usually at the outside edge of the arms.

D (Depth) is from the front of the piece to the deepest part of the back, including the pitch.

H (Height) is the highest part of the back, usually at the top of the back cushion.

SH (Seat Height) is from the floor to the top of the crown of the seat cushion.

SD (Seat Depth) is from the front of the seat cushion to the bottom of the back cushion or inback if the piece is a tight back. Please note that once the piece is sat in, the back cushion will compress and gain from 2"-4" more depending on the weight of the person.

AH (Arm Height) is from the floor to the top of the arm. If the arm has varying heights, the arm height is based on the front of the arm.

ISW (Inside Seat Width) is from the inside of one arm to the inside of the other arm - full width of seating area.
